



# 29<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL TEXAS SHOOTOUT ONLINE CHECK-IN INSTRUCTIONS

All U15 and older teams are required to check-in online through Got Soccer. All U10-U14 teams will check in at the Tournament Headquarters Tent at Dyess Park (U10-U12) and Lindsay/Lyons Park (U13-U14) 1-hour prior to their first game on Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup>.

- Online Check-in Deadline:
  - U15-U19 Teams: Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup> by 5PM
- There will be no exceptions or extensions allowed!
- All teams will receive a confirmation email stating that their check-in documents were complete no later than Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- Instructions for online check-in can be found below:

## INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO CHECK-IN ONLINE:

1. Log in to your Got Soccer Team Account. Under Event Registration History, click on the 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Texas Shootout. Click on the Documents tab on the far right. This is where you will upload your documents.
2. Documentation:
  - a. Official State Roster (event roster generated from the team account) or US Club Soccer Roster or National organization roster (if other): with all players that will be playing on the roster – including guest players – can be written in: all players need to have uniform numbers on the rosters. Guest players from outside of the club will need guest player forms. Guest player forms, medical releases and player passes for guest players should be at the end of each document.
  - b. Medical Release Forms in alphabetical order by Last Name – you can use your own medical release; it does not need to be notarized
  - c. Player & Coach ID Cards – we need the front of all player and coach ID cards scanned and uploaded. The cards need to be in alphabetical order by Last Name.
  - d. Permission to Travel – does not apply to US Club Soccer teams or teams from South Texas. Also, if you are a US Youth Soccer team and your State Association denied your Permission to Travel request, email Ashley Fendley-Frazier to let her know at [shootout@challengesoccer.com](mailto:shootout@challengesoccer.com). Your team is still allowed to attend our event and is covered by additional insurance we purchased to cover US Youth Soccer teams.
  - e. DO NOT SUBMIT DOCUMENTS ELECTRONICALLY UNTIL ALL DOCUMENTS ARE READY – SUBMIT EVERYTHING AT ONE TIME!
